

# Grading Rubric for Annotated Bibliography

## Preliminary Work

- -5 points = missing rough draft (Prep for Project)
- -5 points = missing peer review (Classmate Comment)

## Final Draft:

1. **30 points: SOURCES** = 5 college-level sources (including at least 2 peer reviewed journal articles) for IP issue
2. **20 points: WORD COUNT** = at least 1000 words total
3. **5 points: SENTENCE-LEVEL EDITING** = grammar, mechanics, diction
4. **5 points: MANUSCRIPT** = MLA manuscript format
5. **5 points: IMAGES** = 5 images total, one per source of title and author page
6. **10 points: MLA DOCUMENTATION** = 5 source info total, Works Cited format
7. **10 points: ASSESSMENT OF CREDIBILITY** = 5 Annotations per source for Assessment of Credibility
8. **10 points: SUMMARY OF CONTENTS** = 5 Annotations per source for Summary of Contents
9. **5 points: REFLECTION OF RESEARCH** = 5 Annotations per source: Reflection of Research
